

KEEPING NORFOLK SAFE Police and Crime Plan Consultation

About your PCC

Giles Orpen-Smellie was elected to serve as your Police and Crime Commissioner (PCC) in May 2021 and one of his primary responsibilities is to publish a Police and Crime Plan.

LALLIN,

That plan will set out what the priorities must be for Norfolk Constabulary throughout the course of this PCC term in order to keep Norfolk residents safe.

The PCC is legally required to produce and publish their Police and Crime Plan within their first year of office.

PCCs are directly elected to be the voice of the people and to deliver on the people's priorities. They are responsible for holding the Chief Constable to account to ensure the priorities are being met – supporting the Constabulary to continue delivering the service people expect and need, but also challenging when required and representing the residents they serve.



As your PCC, Giles now wants to hear from the people of Norfolk on what their policing priorities are so that their views can help him shape his new Police and Crime Plan.

Please take the time to consider the information in this document and have your say. The consultation will run from Monday 26 July to Friday 20 August 2021.

A message from Giles

As your Police and Crime Commissioner (PCC), I am responsible for holding the Chief Constable to account for operational policing. One of the ways I achieve this is by developing a Police and Crime Plan that takes account of the local policing priorities that matter to you.

When you take part in my survey I will be able to use your responses, along with information from the Chief Constable and other partner organisations, to inform the development of my Police and Crime Plan.




