Aerosols

Household chemicals and cleansers





Photographic chemicals



Wood preservatives, treatments and varnishes



💙 Fire extinguishers

🏹 Garden pesticides and fertilizers

Can't Unfortunately, we **will not** be able to accept:

🗙 Ammunition, explosives or marine flares



Asbestos



Commercial hazardous waste



Gas canisters (full or part-full)



Petrol, diesel or any other fuels



Advice to householders visiting on **Household Hazardous Waste Days**

- 1. Products for disposal should be kept in their original containers and not mixed together.
- 2. Containers should be clearly labelled where possible.
- 3. When transporting hazardous waste make sure it is properly sealed to avoid leakage.
