2. Three salad types in a bowl
3. Plate of 4 potatoes
4. Onions, 3 trimmed
5. 3 Courgettes
6. Heaviest vegetable
7. Funniest vegetable
8. Any other vegetable, not root veg
9. Any other root vegetable, minimum 3
10. A vase of 4 culinary herbs, 1 stem of each
11. A plate of fruit, minimum 6 in number
12. Heaviest cherry tomato competition
13. Bowl of fruit or veg (children under 12)

Cookery

14. Victoria sandwich with jam only filling
15. 3 Cheese scones
16. 4 Biscuits on a plate

Rules

1. All entries have to be grown or produced by the exhibitor.
2. Entry fees of 50p per entry must be submitted to Jan Lodge at the Old Forge, Aylsham Road by 7th August 2026.
3. All exhibits must be staged on 30th August between 08:30am and 10:30am. Maximum of two entries per class per exhibitor.
4. Judging will take place between 10:30 and 12:00 noon. Judge's decision is final.
5. Points will be awarded:

3 for first, 2 for second, 1 for third.

- A trophy will be awarded at 3:00pm to the person scoring the most points overall.
- There will be awards in the Vegetable and Best Front Door sections.
- All children entering will receive a prize.
- Entries cannot be removed before 3:30 pm
- Any entry not collected by 4:00 pm will be auctioned off with the proceeds going towards the fund
